### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms will be celebrated for the month of May next **Sunday, 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2019 at 11:00 am** in Saint Peter's Church. **Always** Baptisms take place on the **First Sunday of the Month**. ## SUMMER GRANT FOR THE PARISH

We have been informed that we were successful again this year in obtaining a grant from the Federal Government to hire a person for this summer for eight weeks for 30 hours a week. The grant will provide for the minimum wage which is now \$11.55 per hour with appropriate benefits and protection. The job will begin on July 2<sup>nd</sup> and conclude on August 26<sup>th</sup>. Applicants must comply with the eligibility requirements for the Canada Summer jobs 2019 program.

1. Applicants must be between the ages of 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment. to return to school on a full-time basis the next academic year;
2. are Canadian citizens or permanent residents or have official refugee protection status under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (foreign students are not eligible);
3. are legally entitled to work in Canada according to relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.

A special committee of the Parish Council will be appointed to conduct interviews and make the award of this job. The student will work under the supervision of Mr. Vern Stafford, our Parish Caretaker.
